#### **TASB Policy Update 114 & Revision to EIA (Local)**

---

##### **Purpose of Report**

Update 114 encompasses changes in law from the 86th Legislative Session that have an immediate effect on the governance and management of the district.

The changes to local policies address the following topics:

- Public participation at board meetings
- Investments and purchasing
- Security issues, including emergency operations plans and security personnel
- Cybersecurity
- Financial exigency
- Weapons in district parking areas
- Gifted and talented programs
- Partnership charters
- Student physical examinations
- Crisis intervention, including threat assessments and trauma-informed care
- Student records
- Requests for public information

Update 114 contains 123 Legal policies and 19 Local policy changes.

EIA (Local) has minor revisions regarding the distribution of report cards for elementary and secondary. Both elementary and secondary report cards are distributed every 9 weeks.

##### **Operational Impact**

These policies guide the District's operation and protect the rights of employees and students. Careful consideration should be given to each policy.

##### **Results**

Over the next several weeks, a first and second reading of these policies will be held. Policies will be adopted at the second reading.
