The driver's got busy with getting the buses for bus inspection before the beginning of the next school year 2018-2019. They clean the buses from top to bottom on the inside and outside. We have one driver that will clean and spray the underneath of the buses while the rest will go inside and wipe and scrub all the walls, seats, windows, dashboards and ceilings. The buses have to be completely cleaned before the mechanics go inside and do any mechanical repairs. We have one driver that will go in the buses and repair all the seats. Everything gets checked before inspection day to make sure the bus will pass inspection not only with cleanliness but with everything in safe and working order. The Highway patrol officer and Supervisor of Transportation will sign off on the inspection sheet that we get out of the O.P.I website. We then send a copy to the Glacier County Superintendent of Schools in Cut Bank.

On the weekend of 6-16-18 our drivers helped in the transporting of the runners for the Glacier half marathon run. We transported them from the Red Eagle campgrounds/ Powwow grounds to 10 miles west of Browning to the starting line then went to East Glacier to transport them back to their sites. It was an early morning run and everything ran smoothly.

We will be attending the Montana Association of Public Transportation in Great Falls on 6-20-18 to 6-22-18. They will have a variety of workshops and speakers for us to attend during these days. There will be lots of good information for us and will give us our 15 hour required training hours we are to have every year.
