



## Safety and Security Update

### December 12th, 2022

- Weekly Door Sweeps continue at every campus - good work, maintenance dept. responding well; a few times doors have been found in “non-compliance, still rare
- Since start of school August 23, 2022 our campuses have conducted the following **safety drills**:
  - 6 “lockdowns” drills
  - 4 “shelter” in place
  - 2 “secure and hold”
  - 13 “evacuation”/“fire” drill
- **Security camera projects** (new and replacement) are moving forward - DAEP/Tiger/BP/HS; equipment ordered and received; work in progress.
- **3 Intruder Audits** were conducted in October and November by State/TEA/Region 13 at JHS, SES, and BP

- **Safety and Security Committee Meeting #2 November 4th** - discussed SPAT grant, “silent panic” buttons/grant; reviewed Safety & Security Projects and Upgrades Timeline; reviewed Safety and Security Update; next meetings 3/6/23, 7/31/23
- **Safe and Supportive Schools Team(SSST)(Threat Assessment) Meeting #2, Dec. 12, 1-2pm** - review FERPA, reviewed “path of violence”; reviewed roles of SSST; conducted actual threat assessment screen; Mar. 3, 2023.
- **“Safety”(100) magnets** ordered, received, and delivered to secondary campuses(Nov.)
- **SPAT grant** - “Silent panic” buttons are soon to be required in Texas schools; we applied for a grant(12/2) to help soften the cost of our “silent panic” button solution
- **TEA/Texas Safety grant** to be released soon; initial meeting of CO; estimated allotment of \$200K; eligible-fencing, cameras, doors,equipment, etc...
