Our Vision & The State Goal

The Mission: To cultivate lifelong learners who are critical thinkers, problem solvers, and leaders.

The Goal: Aligning Navarro ISD with the TEA 2024 State Plan to move from "Accountability" to an **Exemplary** rating.

Program Evaluation: Data-Driven Success

Our program has seen a transformative increase in both identification and service delivery.

Enrollment Trends (2022–2025)

- **Rapid Growth:** In May 2022, we served 64 students. As of **September 2025**, we have identified and are serving **265 students**.
- **Current Reach:** 8% of the total district population is now receiving G/T services.
- **Total Identified (Current):** 265 Students.
- **Active Pipeline:** 120 Students currently referred and awaiting testing.
- **Total Impact Reach:** 385 Students (Identified + Referred).
- **District Reach Metrics:**

Currently Identified: 8% of the 3,073 total enrollment.

Projected Potential Reach: 12.5% of the student body.

- **Growth Narrative:**

May 2022: 64 students.

Jan 2024: 145 students.

Sept 2025: 265 students.

2026 Projection: Potential for **385+ students** based on current referrals.

Navarro ISD Panther Path

Gifted/Talented

A visual representation of the G/T learning continuum through the four stages of a panther's growth.

Panther Cub

Kinder-2nd



The foundational level, where students are beginning their educational journey and developing core skills. This is the stage of identification and discovery.

Junior Panther

3rd-8th



This level signifies significant growth and increased academic focus, aligning with skill development and specialization in the intermediate and junior high years.

Varsity Panther

9th-12th



The level of high school, representing mastery, competition, and leadership. Students apply their advanced knowledge and skills in rigorous academic pursuits.

Legacy Panther

Graduates



The highest level, representing the culmination of a student's journey. This is an honorary title for a graduate who will be a lifelong learner and leader.
