

Brownwood ISD Technology Board Report November 11, 2019

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to give an update on projects that the Technology Department has been working on recently and what we have planned for the future.

District Computing Devices

Technology has become such an important part of everyday life. Brownwood ISD makes it a priority to give staff and students the tools necessary to be successful.

Our technology department currently supports approximately 3742 computing devices in addition to well over 800 other devices such as Promethean boards, printers, document cameras, and network related equipment.

An overview of available computing devices is as follows:

Security Within the District

Building security continues to expand throughout the District. This year, Coggin Intermediate School will be outfitted with 7 additional door access controllers and 34 security cameras. An additional 14 security cameras will be installed to address the aging Middle School cameras as well as one in the front office of both the High School and Middle School.

Both the door access control system and the security camera system for all campuses can be managed from a single centralized point.

Next year we plan on outfitting another campus or two with the same physical security systems.

Teacher Laptop Replacement

One hundred 13" MacBook Airs have been ordered to replace older laptops in the hands of teachers. By adhering to this replacement cycle we can ensure that our teachers have up-to-date equipment to assist with their instruction.

High School Laptop Rollout

The High School 1-to-1 laptop program is still going strong. Laptops were rolled out during registration and continued into the first two weeks of school.



13" MacBook Air

Freshmen received new 13" MacBook Airs this year. This was different from the 11" models of previous years. Apple discontinued the 11" MacBook Air but we were able to secure the same pricing for the new 13" Air.

Elementary iPads

This year, 315 iPads for elementary classrooms were configured and distributed. This allowed us to place 5 iPads in every K-3 classroom.

Teachers can request apps and they are pushed out instantly

Another significant addition of technology this year has been the 225 Chromebooks for the Coggin Intermediate campus. These laptops were placed in 9 carts to give each grade level access to 3 classroom sets for checkout.

Brownwood ISD continues to keep technology in the classrooms up to date by replacing outdated equipment at the end of it's lifecycle. As in previous years, desktops in the classrooms are in the process of being swapped out, projectors and document cameras are being replaced, and 2 computer labs will be replaced.
