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Purpose of Waiver

- To allow Ms. De Los Santos to continue serving as teacher of record while completing remaining TExES exams and PPR requirements
 - To ensure compliance with House Bill 2 certification mandates
 - To maintain instructional continuity for Intermediate students
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Certification Completion Plan

- **Spring 2026:**
 - Retake Mathematics and Social Studies TExES (May 2026)
 - **Upon Passing Content Exams:**
 - Register for and complete STR (if required)
 - Register for and pass PPR
 - **By Start of 2026–2027 School Year:**
 - Obtain full standard certification in assigned subject area
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District Supports and Accountability

- Ongoing monitoring of exam registration and completion
 - Coordination with Web Centric regarding certification progress
 - Administrative check-ins to ensure HB 2 compliance
 - Campus mentoring and instructional coaching support
