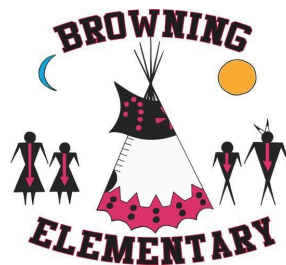

The third grade team has been preparing for the next set of math and reading standards that will be assessed for MAST for window 3 which opens March 24th until May 2. The math standards that will be assessed are: (1) Unit Square and Square Units, (2) Solve Area Problems, (3) Data and Graphing and (4) Two-dimensional Geometric figures. In reading, third grade students will be assessed on reading standards for end of the year literacy text and end of the year informational text.

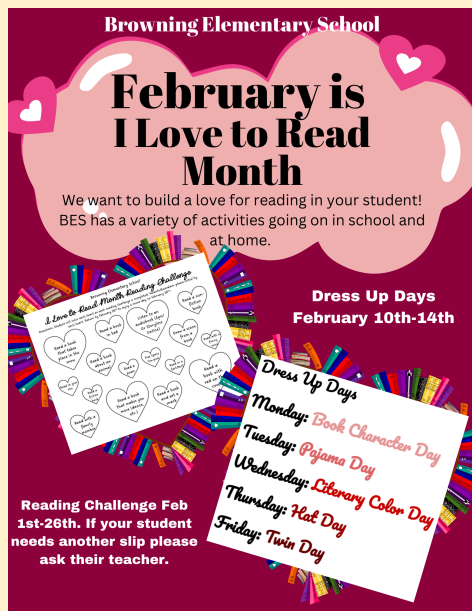

Science of Writing

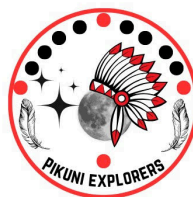

Team name is Pikuni Explorers. Below is the club's mission patch. The four red dots represent the four members of the team. They are excited to compete in this year's challenge.



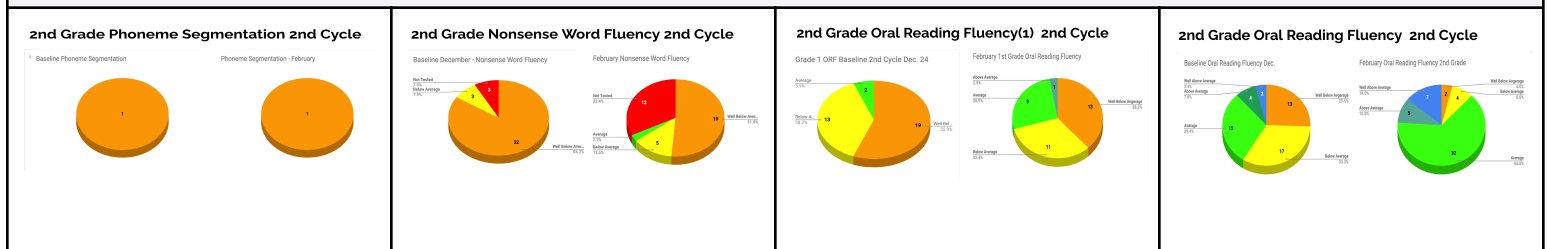

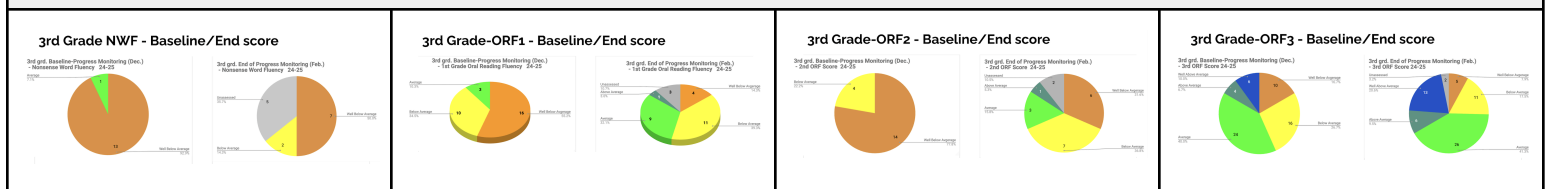
In February we held our 2nd cycle MTSS meeting for both grade levels. Teachers updated Fall to Winter benchmark data based on tiers. Then they moved the sticky notes based on how students scored for progress monitoring. Following the MTSS meeting teachers gave a survey level assessment for their 3rd cycle PDSA to determine the baseline score along with setting their Progress Monitoring goals to begin March 10, 2025 to May 20, 2025.

The following pie graphs show the baseline number compared to the last progress monitoring score for Phoneme Segmentation, Nonsense Word Fluency, 1st grade Oral Reading Fluency, and 2nd Grade Oral Reading Fluency and 3rd grade Oral Reading Fluency.
