## SUMMER SCHOOL SUMMARY

Summer school will be held at the following locations:

East Minico	June 6 <sup>th</sup> – July 14 <sup>th</sup> 8:00 – 1:30 Grades 6 – 12
JDC	June 6 <sup>th</sup> – July 29 <sup>th</sup> (Jackie will do June/Sylvia July) 8:00 – 1:30
Migrant Ed	June 6 <sup>th</sup> – July 23 <sup>rd</sup> (Held at TLC) 8:00 – 1:30 Grades - Preschool – 5
Special Ed	August 2 <sup>nd</sup> – 11 <sup>th</sup> (Held at TLC) 9:00 – 12:00 Grades - Preschool - 2

Breakfast and lunch will be served with the exception of the special ed session. Only snacks will be served.

There will be approximately 13 staff members for 30 days of summer school plus one secretary/administrator. There will be one certified and one classified for the special ed session.

Dr. Cox will check with Brian and Tim to see how many special ed students will be attending summer school. He will have Brian contact Tim to make sure they are doing the same procedure for scheduling students for summer school.

John will work with Kent as to how many computer labs are needed. A list will be given to Dr. Cox as to where the labs are being moved from by May 20<sup>th</sup>.

John will work with East and West in registration of students in Powerschool (summer school box is checked). He will also work with teachers to make sure attendance is being done and students are listed in a class.

Dr. Cox would like to see advisors help with scheduling students. The registration deadline has been set to May 20<sup>th</sup>.

John will submit a proposal to the Board to increase the fee of those students who take summer classes to graduate early from \$50 to \$75. Kolby Dexter will check students to see if this fee can be waived because they are enrolled in the 8 to 6 program.

John will work with Kent to see if the automated calling system can be set to call those students who are enrolled in summer school on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Theo asked that all classroom be used on the bottom level of East before moving upstairs.
