- The purpose of a District of Innovation or School of Innovation is to better prepare students for success in life and work.



# District of Innovation Overview

- Districts offering innovative programs may need flexibility to meet goals and performance targets in the following areas:
- Reducing achievement gaps among groups of public school students who are identified as academically low-achieving
- Increasing pupil learning through the implementation of high, rigorous standards
- Increasing participation of all students or subgroups of students in various curriculum
- Increasing the number of students who are college- and career-ready and reduce the number of students that exit high school in need of remediation
- Motivating students by expanding curriculum choices and learning opportunities

# District of Innovation Overview

- **Average Daily Membership instead of Average Daily Attendance** – Grenada, Corinth, Vicksburg-Warren
- **Seat time** – Grenada, Booneville/Baldwyn, Corinth, Gulfport, Vicksburg-Warren
- **Required number of class days** – Vicksburg-Warren
- **Carnegie units** – Grenada, Corinth, Gulfport, Vicksburg-Warren
- **Blended curriculum** – Grenada, Corinth, Gulfport, Vicksburg-Warren
- **Gifted student requirements** - Corinth
- **ACT Aspire instead of Mississippi Statewide Assessment System for Accountability** – Grenada
- **MAAP testing schedule related to assessment dates** – Booneville/Baldwyn, Corinth
- **Accountability model based on career and technical course participation and proficiency** – Booneville/Baldwyn
- **Teacher certification** – Booneville/Baldwyn, Corinth, Gulfport, Vicksburg-Warren
- **Maximum number of students taught in a day** – Vicksburg-Warren



# District of Innovation Process

- **Year prior** – Notify the designated MDE office of interest or intent to apply for District of Innovation status by August 31.
- **August to October** – Work with MDE contact and stakeholders to develop plan for the innovative school district.
- **November 1** – Submit plans to the designated MDE office for schools planning to open in the following year.
- **December** – Prepare district leadership. Key stakeholders from districts will participate in MDE interview.
- **February** – Present recommendations to the State Board of Education.
- **March** – District of Innovation notifications.
