Here, the 6th grade students work on environmental education. **Busses will depart from CRES on Wednesday, March 25th, at approximately 9:30 a.m. and will return to CRES by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, March 27th.** Staff, parent volunteers, and students will be staying overnight on both Wednesday and Thursday. We are looking forward to providing a unique opportunity in this outdoor setting for your child through the generous support of the PTO, local fire departments, CLEF, CRMC, and other sponsors.

If this is your child's first opportunity to stay overnight away from home (without you present), please talk about this event with your child to help make this a successful experience. There are always adult leaders present in the dorm and participating with students during all learning activities.

Students must pack and be prepared for outdoor activities. Please refer to the list of appropriate gear detailing items useful for this trip. This list will be sent out closer to the trip dates. Meals and snacks will be provided for the duration of the trip. **Therefore, students should not bring food with them.** Students are also not allowed to bring cell phones or electronic devices on this trip.

Please review appropriate behaviors for the trip with your child. Disrespectful or serious misbehavior on the part of your child may result in you being called to pick up your child from Long Lake. We will be employing a three strikes and you are out policy. Students will be given three warnings, and then, you will be called. By signing this permission slip, you agree to this condition regarding student misbehavior.

Students will need to contribute **\$50.00** for this field trip. The amount to attend Long Lake without the donations of CLEF and local Fire Departments is typically \$180 dollars. If you choose not to allow your child to go, they are expected to come to school as usual. Alternate activities will be planned.
