



**Date of Board Meeting:** March 26, 2024

**Subject:** Add Student Technology fee for Radiologic Technology (RADT) Program

**Recommendation:** Approve RADT Student Technology Fee of \$160 per student, effective fall 2024

**Background and Rationale:**

The Radiologic Technology (RADT) program has successfully used Clover Learning Rad-Tech Boot Camp as an instructional and testing support platform. The software has been utilized in RADT for eight years and the five-year licensure pass rates have increased to 93%. Students have not paid a fee for this software as the Perkins grant covered the cost for the last three years. Perkins funds are no longer available to maintain this software and will be used to enhance (not supplant) the program's instruction.

The request is to add a RADT student fee of \$160 per student to RADR 2309. Clover Learning provides review modules for licensure test preparation, allows creation of practice quizzes, and offers instructional materials for faculty-led remediation to help students improve specific content areas once content weaknesses are identified.

**Cost and Budgetary Support:** No cost. Estimated revenue from fees is \$2880, (\$160 X 18 students)
