BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The district instructional data dashboard provides the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.
- In an effort to recognize and reinforce high-functioning collaborative teams, AISD will identify collaborative teams throughout the school year that engaging in PLC actions on a consistent basis. Recognition of the collaborative teams will take place at a school board meeting.
- Beginning in June of 2021, AISD will launch the R3 Summer Learning Academies which will offer four unique summer programs that are designed to target intervention and fill gaps for as many students as possible. The goal of the AISD R3 Summer Learning Academies is to “Recharge, Refresh and Reimagine” summer learning experiences that are offered to students that need additional academic support.
- The R3 Summer Learning Academies are an expansion of summer learning opportunities beyond the state required components. The four summer programs that will be offered to selected students are as follows:

R3 Language Academy

- Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten ESL Program Participants
- June 2-4, 7-10, 14-17, 21-24
- Required to offer 120 hours
- Explicit reading and language intervention designed to increase reading and language proficiency

R3 Reading Academy

- K-2nd grade students based on local reading data
- June 2-3, 7-10, 14-17, 21-24
- Explicit reading intervention designed to increase students' independent reading level

R3 Reading, Math, & STEM Academy

- 3rd-8th grade students based on local reading and math data
- June 7-10, 14-17, 21-24
- Targeted reading and math intervention in addition to daily STEM activities designed to promote engagement, critical thinking, and problem-solving

EOC/Credit Recovery Summer Learning

- 9th-12th grade students based on EOC results and course credit
- June 7-11, 14-18, 21-25 (June 22-25 EOC retesting)
- Targeted support on essential course standards

FISCAL INFORMATION:

- Local and federal funds will be used to pay teachers and purchase program supplies.
