BACKGROUND INFORMATION

"A student not actually on campus at the time attendance is taken may be considered in attendance for FSP purposes if the student is participating in an activity that is approved by your local school board and is under the direction of a professional staff member of your school district or an adjunct staff member. The adjunct staff member must have a minimum of a bachelor's degree and be eligible for participation in the Teacher Retirement System of Texas. Students participating in any activity that is not approved by your local school board or without certified district personnel supervision must be counted absent. For attendance to qualify for funding purposes, the certified district staff member or adjunct staff member must be accompanying the student as an official of your school district for the specific purpose of supervising the students and must be approved by your school board to supervise the activity."
