	The Board approved the 2022-23 Countywide Staffing plan with
	the exception of school psychology which we are still working on
	and will present in March. This plan includes OT, PT, Social
	Workers, EL Services, Speech Therapists and Instructional
	Coaches. The proposal included an additional OT, EL Teacher
	and a Translator. Motion passed 5-0.
	The Board approved the 2022-23 GCED Program Staffing. This
	proposal includes staffing for REACH, STEP, Pathways 6-7,
	Pathways 8-12, Tower View and 5RiversOnline. The proposal
	was a 0.6 FTE increase in teaching. Motion passed 5-0.
	The Board approved Policy Updates at the recommendation of
	MSBA. MSBA is in the process of deep review and revision of
	existing policies. Because the revisions reflect legal changes that
	the Minnesota legislature adopted; or update references rather
	than substantive policy language, a school board may adopt the
	revisions in a single meeting pursuant to MSBA Model Policy
