MESD VEHICLES

The Board may approve the purchase of vehicles to be used by staff for MESD business and transportation services, including student transportation. The Superintendent or designees will shall adopt regulations that define the appropriate use and maintenance of MESD vehicles and the responsibilities of MESD staff and students using those vehicles. The regulations will shall be in compliance with state statutes and the administrative rules of the State Board of Education.
