As an example of how all this works, if we have just 50 supporters buying \$10.00 worth of books each month, our school library would have \$300.00 during the year to spend at Oregon Books.

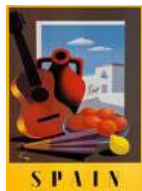

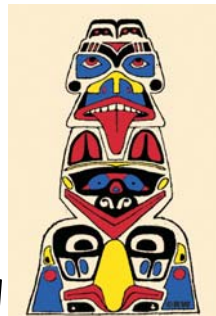
