To bring this mission to life, Greenway Public Schools is committed to developing a clear and shared set of graduate attributes—the essential skills, mindsets, and values we want every student to master by graduation. These attributes ensure our learners are prepared for success in a rapidly changing world.

A graduate attribute list brings Greenway's mission to life by defining success beyond test scores—highlighting independent thinking, respect, and lifelong learning. It equips students with critical skills like communication, resilience, and adaptability, while honoring diverse perspectives and promoting a safe, respectful school culture. The attributes align curriculum and instruction and foster strong partnerships among families, staff, the school board, and the community. Most importantly, they ensure students graduate ready to meet the challenges of a changing world with confidence and purpose.

In March 2025, Greenway Public Schools partnered with PartnerED to begin the planning process for developing a Portrait of a Graduate. To ensure broad input, a stakeholder engagement process was launched. Students from RISE and Student Council were surveyed for their perspectives, and a community-wide POG survey was distributed via Parent Square and Facebook to gather feedback from parents and other stakeholders. Invitations were extended to families, community members, and school board representatives to participate in a core planning meeting scheduled for May. Teachers at both the elementary and high school levels contributed input through their PLCs. The next steps include finalizing the Portrait of a Graduate attributes, developing an implementation plan, and utilizing staff inservice days during the 2025–2026 school year for planning and preparation, with full implementation set for the 2026–2027 school year.
