For late start or total school closure:

If a decision is made to <u>delay or close school</u> the district office follows these steps to notify parents:

- Post on FlashNews, this goes out to all Portland area TV stations as well as local radio stations. Here is a link to go sign up for this http://flashalert.net/news.html?id=1123.
- Post on District website (nknsd.org) page—Neah Kah Nie School District #56.
- Activate School Messenger This system calls all families It is important to keep your phone numbers up to date Baring any internet issues this process should be completed by 6:15 a.m.

For early dismissal for GGS: (weather alerts, power outage, etc.)

- If we have power, the office will activate School Messenger to notify families that school is closing early and approximate times students will leave the school and the District Office will post on flashnews.
- District will post on NKN Facebook.
- If there is no power, the office must use what parents provided for emergency school closure—please make sure this information is up to date!!!

#### Dear Parents and Staff:

Currently there is much in the news about the Novel Coronavirus. Here is what we want you to know about this illness.

# What is the Novel Coronavirus?

Novel Coronavirus is a virus that cause respiratory illness in people.

# What are the symptoms of Novel Coronavirus?

Patients have reportedly had mild to severe respiratory illness with symptoms of fever, cough, and shortness of breath.

# How can I help protect myself and my family?

The best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed to this virus. There are simple, everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses. These include:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcoholbased hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.

# If you are sick, to keep from spreading respiratory illness to others, you should:

- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Actualmente hay muchas noticias sobre el nuevo coronavirus. Esto es lo que queremos que sepa sobre esta enfermedad.

# ¿Qué es el nuevo coronavirus?

El nuevo coronavirus es un virus que causa enfermedades respiratorias en las personas.

# ¿Cuáles son los síntomas del nuevo coronavirus?

Según los informes, los pacientes han tenido una enfermedad respiratoria ya sea leve o severo con síntomas de fiebre, tos y falta de aliento.

# ¿Cómo puedo ayudar a protegerme a mí y a mi familia?

La mejor manera de prevenir la infección es evitar exponerse a este virus. Existen acciones preventivas simples y cotidianas para ayudar a prevenir la propagación de virus respiratorios. Éstos incluyen:

- Evitar el contacto cercano con personas que están enfermas.
- Evite tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca con las manos sin lavar.
- Lávese las manos con frecuencia con agua y jabón durante al menos 20 segundos. Use un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol que contenga al menos 60% de alcohol si no hay agua y jabón disponibles.

# Si está enfermo/a, para evitar transmitir enfermedades respiratorias a otros, debe:

- Quédese en casa cuando esté enfermo/a.
- Cubra su tos o estornude con un pañuelo desechable, luego tírelo a la basura.
- Limpie y desinfecte objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia.
