

# Babb Elementary School Board Report March, 2024

#### K-1 Classroom

K-1 continues to focus on SEL (Social Emotional Learning). Students are learning how to use language to uplift and encourage others. Students are also learning to acknowledge that failure is part of the learning process and that it is ok to fail, but it is not ok to give up. Kindergarten is continuing to learn alphabet letters. They are working on identifying initial and final sounds in words. First graders are practicing segmenting phonemes. First graders are identifying pattern words in passages. Kindergarteners and first graders continue to read decodable books and practice their high-frequency words. In math, Kindergarteners are modeling the decomposition of numbers using story situations, arrays, and number bonds. First graders finished up with ordering and comparing length measurements as numbers. They also had the opportunity to collect, sort, and organize data. All students were learning about leaders and how government helps us. They also created a map of our area, identifying mountains and bodies of water. In science, they focused on heating and cooling by doing hands-on experiments to see how liquids change to solids and vice versa.

All students in Kindergarten and first grade have completed their District Writing Assessment. Dessa was completed for all students K-6.

### 3-6 Classroom

In math the 3rd graders are working on placing fractions on the number line and comparing fractions. 4th and 5th are multiplying fractions with whole numbers. 6th grade students are using the Multiplication and Division Property of Equality. In Science we are working on Extreme Weather.
