Re: Extended School Year and Summer School

Mr. Meadows,

I request to present a plan for offering extended school year and summer school for the summer of 2012. The extended school year will follow five different models based on grade levels k-2, 3-5, 6-7, and 9-12 and Special Education grades k-12. Summer school will be offered only for grades 9-12.

Extended School Year will be offered for students based on the following criteria:

3-5	Teachers recommendations	Failure in Reading and Math	Tier III of RTI
6-8	Failing up to 2 courses	Students who will attend HSAA for the 12/13 school year

Summer School will be offered only to high school students. Students who enroll in and successfully complete summer school will be able to obtain 1 Carnegie Unit. Academic alternative students and seniors will be given priority for the limited number of A-Plus slots available.
