





Burleson and Travis ES

- Construction was ongoing at Burleson from April throughout Summer
- Burleson has successfully reopened to serve PK students
- Amstar is back on-site to finalize remaining items
- Subcontractors are currently focused on Travis
- Trenching is underway to replace plumbing lines throughout the building
- Substantial completion for Travis is anticipated for December



Technology – Surveillance Project

- This project is at 50% total completion
- To date, ECISD has received 2,035 cameras

Notes:

- 1 Moved MS land costs and matching budget from land project to MS project totaling \$794,898.
- 3 Unused funds of \$10m from the Transportation Facility and unused funds of \$3,735,916 from land purchase were reallocated to the CTE High School.
- 3 CTE High School donation from PSP of an additional \$10 million is accounted for separately in Fund 468 so that it is not commingled with bond funds.
- 4 Moved budget of \$10m to CTE High School.
- 7 Unused funds from land purchased were reallocated as follows: MS \$794,898; CTE HS \$3,735,916, and \$20,199 for JROTC facility.
- 15 Moved from land project to ROTC facility to cover slight increase in cost of \$20,199.
- 19 Moved budget of \$14,200 from one light project to the other.
- 21 Moved budget of \$14,200 from one light project to the other.
