SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF DESIGN DEVELOPMENT FOR ANCILLARY BUS PARKING

BOARD GOAL: All systems in the Keller Independent School District will be effective, efficient, and accountable in support of the District's Mission.

FISCAL NOTE: 2008 Bond Funds

Background Information:

- Approximately 90% of the buses that handle the District's transportation needs are stored at the District facility located in the Northwest portion of the District at 11300 Alta Vista Road. Currently any ancillary bus parking has been accommodated at Fossil Ridge High School.
- The initial proposed location for the Multi-Purpose Instructional Facility provided significant space for ancillary bus parking. When the new location for the Multi-Purpose Instructional Facility was determined the District began researching potential locations for the ancillary bus parking lot. The Administration has determined the District's property North of Johnson Road provides the best solution to the District's ancillary bus parking needs. The location will provide buses to be stored on the east side of the District which will allow for shorter bus routes and provide cost savings related to fuel and drive time.
