Call to Order

Becky Carter-Beeson called the meeting to order at 7:00AM in the Pana School District Office.

Roll Call

Members present for the meeting were Becky Carter-Beeson, Josh Ishmael, Eric Kingery and Lori Magnussen. Jason Bauer (Superintendent) was also present as well as Mark Beyers (school board member). Mike Cothern and Sarah Burris were absent.

Josh made a motion to approve the minutes of the PEF of July 2023, motion seconded by Eric. All yes.

Treasurer's Report

As Mike was absent, Josh reported that the statement balance was \$82,817 and the CD balance is \$173,000. Presently there are no outstanding checks. Josh noted there is a maturing CD in November 2023. After discussion it was a unanimous decision to help Matt Miller with funds for the Veteran's Day program at the Jr High this year. Josh made the motion with a second from Eric. All in favor. Becky presented a bill for payment for pencils to TAP Business Systems in the amount of \$370 to be distributed at the Labor Day parade. Josh made a motion to pay and Lori seconded. All were in favor. The Committee discussed having a permanent PEF banner made for the gym - Beck and Josh will work in this. It is estimated the banner will cost \$100. Josh made a motion to approve with a second from Lori. Again, all in favor. Lastly, theTreasurer's Report was approved on a motion made by Eric and seconded by Josh. All in favor.

(The Committee discussed putting another case outside of the gym to recognize volleyball donors - Mark will take a look at the electrical strip options in that area.) It was noted again that the recent grants from Sparklight and GPI were \$7500 and \$5000 respectively and hopefully we can obtain these amounts on a yearly basis.
