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**SUBJECT:**

Contract For Goalbook

**RATIONALE:**

In accordance with Texas State Law, an approved procurement method is required for the acquisition of goods or services totaling over \$50,000.00 within a 12-month period. While this individual contract falls below that threshold, the district seeks formal approval to ensure continued compliance and transparency in specialized service acquisition.

The proposed partnership with [Goalbook](#) (Huntsville ISD) is designed to build teacher capacity and improve student outcomes within the Special Education department. This platform directly supports the district's mission by providing:

**Data-Driven Precision:** Guides educators in accurately identifying student "Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance" (PLAAFP) using objective data.

**Compliance & Efficiency:** Streamlines the development of standards-aligned, compliant IEP goals tailored to individual student needs, saving valuable administrative time.

**Instructional Excellence:** Provides instant access to research-based strategies and classroom-ready resources, ensuring that Specially Designed Instruction (SDI) is implemented effectively and progress is monitored consistently.

The total cost for this contract period is \$37,084.50. This rate reflects a multi-year partnership discount, providing a cost-effective solution for high-quality instructional management.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the contract with Goalbook for the period of July 1, 2026, through August 21, 2027, in the amount of \$37,084.50.
