





25 year contract

Long term agreement is actually a benefit

- Provides predictable savings over time
 - Future energy prices are unknown
 - CSG savings are guaranteed Bill Credit and PPA cost for the entire term are fixed
- Provides Stability
 - CSG program is regulated by the MN Public Utilities Commission and Department of Commerce
- Long term cash flow
 - The current School Board can leave a legacy for future boards

Subscription is transferable

- Transfer to another District owned facility
- Sell your subscription to another entity
- Can be terminated by the District in the event of facility closing (with 24 months notice).

• What if better panels come along?

- The newest technology is NEVER the cheapest.
- Generation expense is only a small portion of the Value of Solar bill credit.

• How long have you been buying electricity from Xcel?

- Are you ever going to stop buying from them?
- What have rates done since 1994?
