**AGENDA ITEM:** 2018-2019 District Instructional Focus Update

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

• The development of an instructional data dashboard will provide the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.

- Instructional Rounds is Aledo ISD's systematic process for monitoring the district problem of practice through an analysis of student learning outcomes.
- Second semester Instructional Rounds at each campus have been completed and data has been compiled and analyzed to determine district-wide reinforcement and refinement areas.
- 324 total classrooms were visited during the Instructional Rounds process this school year and student tasks were rated on a continuum ranging from beginning to well-developed levels in the following indicators: thoughtful work, high-level questioning, academic discussion, active participation, and learning environment.
- A comparative analysis of first semester and second semester Instructional Rounds data provided the district with overall patterns and trends of student learning based on the Rigor and Learner Engagement Rubrics.
