### GOAL 1: Student Achievement

01

*Fall MAP  
Results*

Students meet or exceed, in aggregate, their growth goals measured through RIT scores and national norms at each grade level.

02

*Student  
Voice*

Students share their voice in their learning during conferences, at board meetings, and within their schools.

03

*Winter MAP  
Results*

Students meet or exceed, in aggregate, their growth goals through RIT scores and national norms at each grade level.

04

*In Person  
Attendance*

Students in the District will be in attendance in person throughout the year at a total rate of 90% or greater.

05

*Spring MAP  
Results*

Students meet or exceed, in aggregate, their growth goals through RIT scores and national norms at each grade level.



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### GOAL 2: Successful Passage of the Referendum

01

*District Social Media*

The District's Facebook page and X (Twitter) account will provide weekly messages related to the referendum up until the election.

02

*District Direct Mailings*

To reach citizens that are not clients of the District, several direct mail items will be sent bulk rate to the community to provide referendum information.

03

*Town Hall Meetings*

Three town hall meetings will be conducted in September to give the public in-person access to the referendum information as well as the opportunity to tour the host building.

04

*Board Communication & Reports*

The Board will receive regular updates on the referendum through the *Thursday Letter* and with public reports at their regular monthly business meeting.

05

*Community Messaging*

Monthly emails and information will be made available in e-newsletters and the website to provide citizens access to the information supporting the projects and calculating the tax impact on residents.



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### GOAL 3:

## Update the Safety Plan and Protocols for the District

01 Create a Safety Committee

The Safety Committee will begin its work in September and meet monthly through May. Minutes will reflect their work.

02 *Review and Revise the Safety Plan*

The Committee will review safety plan templates and the current plan to revise in accordance with new county guidance for recommendation to the Board of Education.

03 *Examine Training Opportunities*

The Committee will review current training as well as updated opportunities like A.L.I C.E. and mandated CPR training for the staff.

04 *Create Agreements for Evacuation sites*

The Board will approve agreements with area agencies that can act as evacuation sites in the event of a building level emergency.

05 *Formal Board of Education Approval of Plan*

The Board of Education will vote in approval of the final Safety Plan following an opportunity to discuss its contents.
