Staffing

The Transportation Department continues to maintain stable operations as the school year comes to a close. Drivers are completing end-of-year responsibilities and preparing for the transition into summer operations and the upcoming school year.

Fleet and Maintenance

The department continues the scheduled maintenance cycle for the bus fleet. Preventative maintenance remains a priority to support safe and reliable transportation. With the start of summer, mechanics will begin full-service maintenance on the bus fleet to prepare vehicles for the upcoming school year. We are also continuing to complete maintenance on additional district vehicles, which allows the district to avoid outsourcing these services and helps reduce overall maintenance costs.

Operations

Daily transportation operations continue to run reliably for students and families across the district as the school year concludes. Drivers are completing end-of-year tasks, including bus cleanout, paperwork, and preparations for next year's operations.

Safety and Training

Updated CPR masks have been distributed to all regular route buses through the support of District Nurse Marijane Nelson. This partnership helps ensure drivers have updated emergency resources available when needed.

Planning

Preparations for the upcoming school year are already underway, with transportation registration now live for families. This early process supports planning and routing development for the 2026–2027 school year. Training schedules are also being developed to support the implementation of the new routing software before the start of school.
