Background Information

<p>Building and Programming Updates</p>	<p><u>Community Education</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Community Education had our summer Kids Junction registration day on March 6, 2024. Currently, we have 300 kids registered for the program which will run 13 weeks, Monday-Friday, 6:00am-6:00pm at Sunnyside Elementary.</li><li>• Community Recreation and City of Red Wing staff met on March 14 to review the current Joint Powers Agreement, programs and budgets to date. The Joint Powers Agreement has been in place for 28 years. Ron Goggin represented the Red Wing City Council and Nicky Buck represented the School Board at the meeting.</li><li>• Community Recreation offered 108 programs during the winter and spring season and will offer over 40 swimming lesson programs this summer due to increased demand for swimming instruction.</li></ul> <p><u>Student Nutrition Services</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We are gearing up for Summer Programming and understanding the new regulations that allows non-congregate feeding now. This is a game changer and could increase participation in our summer feeding substantially.</li><li>• We are celebrating our annual nod to the MN Twins and have our Twins Day planned for April 19th. We will have a special ballpark menu for this day and kids that participate in School Lunch that day will be entered to win a pair of Twins Tickets.</li><li>• We have awarded our Sunnyside walkin freezer/cooler contract and are looking at our first construction meeting to be held on April 10th. We will get a better idea of time lines in the completion of this project.</li></ul>
