Dear Dr. Pollard,

As you may be aware, the process for the election of members for the Board of Directors of the Coryell Central Appraisal District was changed in the 2023 legislative session. The process now requires the appointed members to have staggered four (4) year terms. The 2026 election process is for two (2) members that were randomly selected from five (5) total members to serve one (1) year terms starting 1/1/2025 and ending 12/31/2025. The two (2) members appointed from this election will serve a four (4) year term from 1/1/2026 to 12/31/2029. The following is a recap of the procedure:

- Members of the Board of Directors are appointed by vote of the taxing unit governing bodies.
- Each taxing unit entitled to vote may nominate, by resolution adopted by its governing body, one candidate for each position to be filled. There are two (2) positions to be filled which means you may nominate up to two persons. The names of these nominees must be submitted to the chief appraiser on or before October 15, or as soon thereafter as possible.
- Before October 30, you will receive a prepared ballot listing the candidates alphabetically.
- The governing body must cast its votes by resolution and submit the resolution to the chief appraiser by December 15.
- 291 is the number of votes your governing body may cast in the election for new board of director members for the Coryell Central Appraisal District.
- The chief appraiser shall count the votes, declare the two (2) candidates who receive the largest cumulative vote totals and submit the results before December 31 to the governing body of each taxing unit in the district and to the candidates.





• The governing body may cast all its votes for one candidate or may distribute their votes among any number of the candidates.

To be eligible to serve as a director, an individual must be a resident of the district and must have resided in the district for two years. An employee of a taxing unit that participates in the district is not eligible to serve <u>unless</u> that person is also a member of the governing body or is an elected official of a taxing unit that participates in the district.

Please submit your nominee(s) by resolution on or before October 15, or as soon thereafter as possible. A sample resolution is included for your review.
