Surveys were administered to parents and staff. Little Raiders Participation: Parents - 46 responses / 49 Staff – 8 responses / 9



### **Parent Survey Highlights**

- 100% indicated my child's school is well-cared and clean
- 98% indicated adults who work in my child's school treat students with respect (1 person somewhat agrees)
- 98% indicated the school communicates effectively/regularly with families (1 person somewhat agrees)
- 100% indicated the learning environment at this school is positive
- 98% indicated the school community respects and embraces diversity (1 person disagreed)
- 100% indicated the school has clear rules and expectations for student behavior

### **Staff Survey Highlights**

- 100% stated this school is a good place for me to work
- 100% stated our staff is welcoming to visitors and parents
- 100% stated I feel welcome and a part of this school community
- 100% stated parents have many opportunities to be involved at the school.
- 100% stated adults in this school treat students with respect.
- 100% stated teachers at this school hold each other accountable for consistently maintaining school-wide expectations.

## **Growth Areas**

#### **Parent Survey Growth Area**

- 91% Parents are involved in making important school decisions.
- 95% The school provides resources or strategies that I can use to support my child's learning at home.

#### **Staff Survey Growth Areas**

- 75% stated School administrators include teachers/staff in schoolwide decision-making and problem-solving (1 somewhat agree, 1 disagree)
- 88% stated The principal communicates regularly and effectively with staff (email, newsletter, week ahead, etc) (1 disagreed)
