





Vision

To improve student achievement through increasing teacher effectiveness.





Purposes

- Improve instructional quality.
 - Increase cost effectiveness.
- 



Goal

In each of the next three school years, we will provide high quality professional development opportunities for all MRVED educators.



Impact of this Program

- 32 administrators
- 557 teachers
- 269 paraprofessionals
- 6575 students

Nine MRVED member districts:

Benson, Dawson-Boyd, Lac qui Parle Valley, Lakeview, Minneota, Montevideo, Ortonville, Renville County West, and Yellow Medicine East.

Ivanhoe, paired with Minneota, is also a part of the proposal.



Teacher Effectiveness

Dr. Bill Sanders and colleagues reported the following:

“ . . . the results of this study well document that the most important factor affecting student learning is the teacher...The immediate and clear implication of this finding is that seemingly more can be done to improve education by improving the effectiveness of teachers than by any other single factor.”



Common Professional Development Days

- ❖ Three common days during each school year that will focus on research-based, high impact instructional strategies.
- ❖ One floating day during districts' workshop days.
- ❖ One Paraprofessional Workshop each fall prior to start of all districts.
- ❖ Six principal and eleven superintendent meetings.
- ❖ Four teacher advisory committee meetings.
- ❖ Facilitate curriculum review and development opportunities for all districts.

Social Emotional Learning (SEL)


Social and emotional learning (SEL) is an integral part of education and human development.

SEL is the process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills and attitudes to develop:

- *healthy identities,*
- *manage emotions and achieve personal and collective goals,*
- *feel and show empathy for others,*
- *establish and maintain supportive relationships, and*
- *make responsible and caring decisions.*



Equity and Inclusivity

- ▶ Value student culture and identity.
 - ▶ Assure that all students receive a high-quality education that prepares them for success; regardless of ability, gender, race, socioeconomic status, first language, or other form of diversity.
 - ▶ These priorities align with “Due North, Minnesota’s Education Plan”.

Curriculum Review and Instruction

Provide districts with training and support for:

- Alignment of curriculum to state academic standards.
- Pacing of curriculum.
- Curriculum review and selection.
- Examining data to guide instructional practices.
- Best practices based on research-based, high impact instructional strategies.



Teacher Support

Provide districts with training and support for:

- PLCs
- Mentoring programs
- Instructional Coaching



Evaluation

The following indicators will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of our program:

- Reduction in the size of the academic achievement gap.
- Student performance on the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments.
- High school graduation rates.
- Career and college readiness using the measures determined by the MDE.
- These indicators align with the World's Best Workforce Goals and Integration and Achievement Goals.



Staggered Start Dates

- ▶ Allows more districts to access the MRVED staff for professional development and technical assistance:
 - ▶ At the beginning of the year.
 - ▶ At quarter and semester breaks.
- ▶ This is a more efficient and effective way of meeting district needs during times when there is a higher demand for MRVED professional staff services.



Funding

- All districts will commit additional funding to allow for shared high quality presenters.
- \$5/student will generate \$33,320.

(Note: Ivanhoe pays \$10/student)
- This equates to **\$3,245.00** for the Lakeview Public School District.



Lakeview Specifics



- ▶ The first six years of the FLY we started two full weeks early, but in the last two plan cycles we started a week and a half early.
 - ▶ Accommodated the Wood Lake Fair
 - ▶ Gave a shorter week to work out minor issues with transportation, student schedules, and other student/staff concerns
- ▶ The calendar provides great alignment with partner colleges and university calendars (prevents students from having an overload for multiple weeks)
 - ▶ Juniors and Seniors take PSEO classes, High School Students taking CTE electives through the MRVCTC.
 - ▶ 2020-21 Start Dates: Lakeview – August 25, SMSU – August 23, MN West – August 23, Ridgewater College – August 23
