Foundation Report from Liz Hamilton: 1/28/19

- 2018 Foundation Financial Update: I'm pleased to report the Foundation ended 2018 receiving 119% of budgeted annual revenue. For the first time, the Foundation grossed over \$400,000 in revenue raised. At the same time, we were able to control expenses and come in under budget for budgeted expenses. A check for over \$26,000 was written to the Library for designated donations and \$75,000 was deposited in our Endowment fund. The current total for our Endowments which are managed by CICF is just over \$650,000.
- The Young Professionals Group has been working closely with Library staff and will hold a Library After Dark event on Saturday, April 13. This will be a ticketed event with activities throughout the Library and will benefit the Foundation. This is an adult only event.
