~~STUDENT SMOKING~~ PROHIBITED USE OF TOBACCO SUBSTANCES

The Board of Education has determined that a nonsmoking policy is ~~necessary~~ appropriate in order to:

- Discourage smoking/~~chewing/vaping~~ and other use of tobacco by students; ~~and to protect~~
- ~~Protect~~ the health of others who may be affected by secondary ~~smoking~~; ~~smoke~~; and
- Enhance and promote a school district curriculum designed to enlighten students on the health hazards of smoking, ~~and other use of tobacco~~; ~~chewing, and vaping tobacco products or other inhalants.~~
- ~~Respond to the enforceability problems of smoking and other use of tobacco by students under legal age; and~~
- ~~Respond to the nationwide health hazard and the attending problems created by smoking and other use of tobacco.~~

Therefore, the ~~The~~ Board of Education has established that ~~no Livonia Public School~~ students shall ~~not~~ smoke, chew, or otherwise use tobacco or other smoking or tobacco substitutes on school property nor shall any student, while on school property, have in his/her possession or under his/her control, ~~cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vaping mechanisms, or~~ tobacco in any form, including tobacco substitutes ~~or other inhalants.~~

The rule against the use and possession of tobacco and tobacco substitutes ~~shall be~~ is included as a ~~under "Prohibited Acts" under in Board Policy JD – Student Discipline~~ the school district's ~~"Procedures Governing Violation of School Rules,"~~ and the penalty for violation of this rule shall range from ~~suspension~~ ~~warning~~ to expulsion.
