Mr. Kelly called the work session to order at 5:35 p.m. All present stood for the flag salute.

Mr. Erlebach introduced Jenice Pizzuto our district RTI specialist. He shared that he, Jenice, Janmarie, Ruth and Kristi all met earlier in the day to review the spring DIBELS data. Ms. Pizzuto stated that it is good to be back. She appreciates being able to work with the Board, administrators and teachers, she stated that Board support is critical.

We have come a long way. Ms. Pizzuto shared that she was a presenter at the RTI Annual Conference, there were over 800 people from across the US and two international countries. She presented on Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS), which is RTI and PBIS together. She shared that while we are implementing RTI we are actually on the cutting edge because of our PBIS initiatives.

She presented year-end data via a PowerPoint which is attached to these minutes.

We have made some big strides this year, our students moving from 5th grade to 6th grade have really improved. The elementary schools have been working on installing interventions. Staff have attended group intervention training, leaning where to intervene, how to intervene, what is the intensity of the intervention. We had 17 students exit out of interventions.

She reminded the board of the 9 essential components of RTI, which are:

- Culture
- Leadership
- Teaming
- Professional Learning
- Core
- Screening
- Interventions
- Progress Monitoring
- SLD Decision Making

Ms. Pizzuto shared the following:

Highlighted areas that the Board is addressing and what the Board may need to address.

- Reviewed the assessment data from last year, which showed that we did not make the expectations for growth. The goal was 5 to 30 percent growth.
- Compared data from the end of last school year to the end of the year this year. We did meet the growth targets except in 3rd grade

Ann Harper shared that RTI is dealing with our readers, she shared a concern about the 90 minute uninterrupted reading block, she feels that is a long time to hold the attention of the younger kids. She asked that as decisions are made that we consider what our kids are dealing with and would like to see the needs of the whole student addressed.

Terry Kelly asked Jenice to address the 90 minute reading block, she stated it is in the Oregon Literacy Framework requirement. There were several teachers in the audience who shared their observations and opinions on the reading block. Discussion occurred.


The Board agreed to continue the three times per year update on the RTI process. The dates of the meetings will be determined at a later date.


Mr. Kelly thanked everyone for coming.


