Re: 21st Century Grant - Lights on for Learning Year 5

The District has entered into a five-year grant agreement with the Rock Island Regional Office of Education (ROE) for the 21st Century Lights on for Learning Grant. The grant is being funded, and fiscal year 2025-2026 is the final year of this agreement.

In accordance with the grant agreement, the District has contracted with three vendors to provide services: Thrive Therapy Support Services for an After-School Wellness Club at a cost of \$22,000, Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Mississippi Valley for Academic Enrichment Programming for families at a cost of \$25,000, and Blackhawk College for Academic Enrichment Programming for families at a cost of \$2,000. All of the contracts are consistent with those provided under year four of the grant.

We recommend approval of the contracts with Thrive Therapy Support Services (\$22,000), Blackhawk College (\$2,000), and Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Mississippi Valley (\$25,000) for the 2025-26 school year.
