Maya Angelou: Extensive new pipes completed for hot/cold water line

**Fields:** New Condenser unit replaced (Existing Condenser unit discard properly and functioning correctly for boilers at facility

**Brooks:** New Carpet and painting of library at Brooks

**Bryant:** Unit modification with new parts to relays on rooftop unit #7 (Note life expectancy routine maintenance upgrade existing parts)

**Sandburg:** Replaced a pump and drained lines at facility in order to take sir out of pipes causing heat to not flow properly. Heating is currently working.

**Whittier:** Sensors recalibrated, New Controls to AAON rooftop unit (Note life expectancy routine upgrade)

After trouble shooting AAON roof top unit came to conclusion that problem is probably in sensors that are controlling discharge air temperature. MV Heating and Air conditioning is working with maintenance tech to check and determine which sensors and controls are malfunctioning and causing classrooms to be overheating, currently bypassing system to stabilize heat in primary area.
