The U.S. Department of Agriculture will continue reimbursing schools and childcare centers for free meals to all students regardless of their income through the 2022 summer. This free meal program has been incredibly successful over past year. The program has ensured that school children do not go hungry and have access to nutritious meals, both breakfast and lunch.

It is likely that the free meal program will cease after this summer, with the elimination of federal funding. Meal prices are typically considered by the Board of Education in the summer for the following school year. This decision awaits further information from the WI Department of Public Instruction.
