Provided over 4500 service hours in 2010-2011



SUN Community Schools

- 85 % of the students who attended SUN 30 days or more were children of color
- MFS SUN leveraged over **\$229,415** of in-kind contributions at Shaver
- School day average daily attendance was 95% for SUN participants







Highlights

- MFS received an **AmeriCorps grant** to bring a full time member to Shaver SUN Community School
- Shaver SUN Food Pantry opened serving 901 people from April-June
- The Helping Hands Holiday Food & Gift Drive for Shaver & Sacramento provided food for 174 families and gifts for 562 children
- Over **65 Community Partners** were involved with Shaver SUN including businesses and non-profits
