BHS what's happening/Has happened:

1. BHS Senior Portfolio- November 22, 2025 we had 80 students present on that day. Tammy is working on getting the rest of the students make up
2. Cat/Griz Assembly had an amazing turn out. All schools were represented and the Student council did a great job with games and keeping the crowd engaged.
3. Attendance: 64 students with 100% attendance AND 39 students with 95%. We had 6 100% last month which means 58 more students earned 100% attendance. Attendance assembly will be held on December 9, 2025 during advisory time.
4. Working with BFCC for additional classes for 2nd semester- We will implement College Writing here at BHS during the 1st period. Which will just be for college credit but next year we will be able to offer dual credit. 3 additional classes will be offered at BCC during the afternoon specifically for BHS seniors who are interested in earning college credit. These students will need to be able to do ½ days at BHS and need to petition for ½ days to the principal.
5. BNSF has confirmed they will donate to BHS this school year to help the welding program. They haven't communicated if the donation will be cash or if they will



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buy the needed items. Once that is communicated, I will send it to the board.

The goal is to help BNSF recruit highly qualified welders to their college. Which in turn they attend BNSF college and go right to work for them.

6. Senior Scholarship Updates- with the expectations to start earlier in the year we are getting confirmation of students applying and being the finalist for some of the national scholarships. We have 2 students in the running for some of the biggest scholarships nationwide.
7. Senior Toy Drive will shop on December 14th, 2025. Wrapping will happen on December 15th, 16th. Gifts will be picked up from Jimi Champ's room December 19th and December 20th.
8. Senior check list is up and posted in the school to keep seniors moving forward and understanding what is still left in the school year. This is posted at the counseling center and in the senior hallway.
