Our intervention systems are in place, students are being monitored on their progress, and we have already moved students out of intervention all together.

I would like to congratulate the Fruitdale Staff and students on a successful year last year. On October 9<sup>th</sup>, it was announced that Fruitdale was named an **Oregon Model School** for the second year in a row. Models schools are high poverty schools that are rated within the top 5% of all Title One Schools in the state. This recognition is identified on the Oregon State Report Card. You will be able to access these report cards online through our website. Take a look at the amount of growth Fruitdale students make as compared to other students throughout the state.

We added a third 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classroom this month. Our class sizes were at 34 students and we were able to create three classes of 22 students each. Mr. Christensen from our Camp Sunrise Classroom became our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher and students and families welcomed him with open arms. He is doing an excellent job of adjusting to a new job assignment.
