BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Aledo ISD SHAC consists of 34 members and began meeting in October 2015. The committee met a total of five times during the 2015-2016 school year. Each year, the SHAC committee is required to make a formal report to the Board of Trustees summarizing its activities for the year.

The primary function of the School Health Advisory Council is to recommend changes to the district's health education instruction.

The SHAC is required to meet at least four times per school year and to establish a subcommittee on physical fitness and activity.

The largest membership of the SHAC must be parents of students enrolled in the district who are not employed by the district.
