## 2025–2026 Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment & TEKS Certification Form

- In accordance with Texas Education Code 31.1011, local educational agencies (LEAs) are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education (SBOE) and the commissioner that students have access to instructional materials covering all Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for all required subjects, except physical education.
- This process ensures the district provides curriculum, core and supplemental instructional materials for core content at all grade levels.



### HB 1605 : Parent Transparency

- Requires local school systems to establish a classroom instructional material review process, under rules set by SBOE
- Requires publishers to make textbooks accessible to parents through internet portals under rule set by SBOE



### Instructional Materials Updates

- . K-5 <u>Math</u> will transition to the Texas Bluebonnet Resources
- SBOE has established a new IMRA process and has established a new funding process with entitlement funds

- Board president and secretary will sign a hard copy this evening upon board approval.
- The data contained in this hard copy will be entered into the TEKS certification form online.
- Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment is set to be released for spending in May 2025.
