- Semester exams are on the horizon. Students have been going to tutorials, working in study groups ect... to prepare.

- MMS has over 100 students competing in UIL Academic Events. The students competed in Brownsboro on 12-9-13 and 12-10-13. UIL one act play performed in Mabank on Saturday 12-14-13.
