Dear School Board Member:

The Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) is calling upon school boards to submit Advocacy Resolutions to update the 2008–10 TASB Advocacy Agenda and, therefore, its position on issues during the interim of the 81st Regular Session of the Texas Legislature.

The Advocacy Agenda—the plan of action TASB pursues during the legislative biennium—consists of two parts:

- Advocacy Priorities—proactive legislative goals arising from TASB’s grassroots process.
- Advocacy Resolutions—reactive stances guiding TASB’s responses to other issues that might arise before the Legislature and other governmental entities.

Midway through the TASB Advocacy Agenda biennium, TASB calls on school districts across the state to submit resolutions for inclusion in or to amend current items in the Advocacy Agenda.

Now TASB is providing your district the opportunity to submit resolutions for the 2008–10 Advocacy Agenda. **Resolution proposals will be accepted until July 1, 2009.**

Proposals submitted after the July 1 deadline will be considered on an emergency basis only. Emergencies are defined not by the seriousness of the subject but by whether or not the issue was triggered by an event occurring after the deadline for submission. Each proposed resolution submitted after the deadline must be accompanied by a statement describing the nature of the emergency.

Proposed resolutions are first reviewed by the TASB Resolutions Committee and then by the TASB Board. In October, the TASB Delegate Assembly will adopt approved resolutions for inclusion in the 2008–10 Advocacy Agenda. The agenda will continue to be in effect for the current biennium, which ends with the conclusion of the 2010 Delegate Assembly.
