Currently, the district has a \$0.759 M deficit for the month of February. Overall, the district has an operational deficit of \$2.935 M with revenues being at 58% of budget and expenses at 76.2% with 78% of the financial calendar expired. The net position will continue to decline over the next month until the 1st installment of the 2018 Tax Levy is realized in June. Last year, the operational deficit was \$1.887 M at this point in the year.

In April, the largest sources of revenue were from the Evidence Based Funding Model (\$153,000), Prior Year's Refunded Expenses (\$106,000), Prior School For All Grant (\$80,000), and the Corporate Personal Property Replacement Tax (\$79,000)

Salaries and Benefits cost \$904,000 in April. Major expenses were for Special Education Tuition (\$214,000) Medical Insurance (\$99,000), and TRS payments (\$52,000)

The first installment on the energy project with CTS Group was made in May (\$172,000). It is estimated that another \$200,000 will be invoiced by the end of the fiscal year.
