Staffing Challenges During COVID-19

We are seeing an Increase in staff close contacts requiring quarantines. The majority of our staff close contact is happening outside of work.

- The most challenging staffing issue is Extended Quarantine (10-14 days).
- Extended Staff Quarantines have increased: 3 in September, 14 in October
- An employee cannot "test out" of a close contact quarantine

Preschool/MAC Programs

- Also experiencing an increase in close contacts
- Limited sub pool even prior to COVID-19
- Additional MAC staff or Early Childhood Coordinator are covering classrooms

Staffing efforts to lessen the challenges

- Hired one daily substitute teacher for each building
- Principals have back-up plans to utilize current staff
- Some teachers are continuing direct instruction from home

Emergency Executive Order 20-94

Authorizing the Commissioner of Education to Take Action to Improve the Education of Minnesota Students During the 2020-2021 School Year

Specifically of note:

- Childcare must be provided to families where all of the legal guardians in the child's household are Tier 1 workers.
- Prioritize providing in-person instruction to students with disabilities who require services that cannot be provided in a distance learning model.
- Encouraged to include asynchronous learning.
- Five instructional days may be used as planning days for improving a model or shifting to a new model.
- Additional time for teacher planning
