### **HISTORY:**

The Board of Trustees has identified Student Outcome Goal 1 as follows:

The percentage of all  $3^{rd}$  grade students that score at the Approaches level on STAAR mathematics will increase from 58% in June 2022 to  $\geq$  85% by June 2028.
