Culinary Arts Fundamentals

Rationale: This course is intended to support the elective needs of our students in the Life Skills programming. This course will allow Special Education Life Skills and SLC program students to safely take Culinary I and have their needs met in safe environment. Students will earn 0.5 high school elective course credit and provide goal opportunities for Individual Education Plans.



Forensics II

Rationale: This course would provide an opportunity for students to further deepen their understanding of Forensics through a second semester of learning. The course will provide 0.5 high school <u>lab science</u> credits required for graduation.

This course that will enable students to develop an understanding of the following Forensics areas: DNA analysis, Toxicology, Entomology, Hair and Fiber analysis, and bullet trajectory and ballistics. Students will use problem solving, critical thinking, and inquiry to explore these areas. This course will involve laboratory activities, projects, textbook material, models, diagrams, and journal writings.

College Preparation Math

Rationale: This course is intended for college bound students who would like additional preparation for college level mathematics such as AP Pre-Calculus or AP Statistics. This class will earn 1.0 high school math credit thus fulfilling the three years required by the State of Illinois.





Technical Math - add Dual Credit

Rationale: Through our partnership with Waubonsee Community College we will enrich our Technical Math Course to provide 1.0 high school and 1.0 community college credit. The course will encompass, but is not limited to number sense and number systems, geometry, and basic algebra delivered through authentic, contextualized, problem based learning environments.
