**Topic:** Approval of CSP (Competitive Sealed Proposals) as the method of Procurement for the Reconstruction and Upgrades of Various Athletic Facilities at United South High School and Lyndon B. Johnson High School.

**Recommendations:**

Administration is recommending Competitive Sealed Proposals (CSP) as the method of procurement for the Reconstruction and Upgrades of Various Athletic Facilities at United South High School and Lyndon B. Johnson High School.

**Rationale:**

As per Government Code 2269.056, the Board of Trustees of a public school district that is considering a construction contract using a method specified by Government Code 2269 must before advertising determine which method provides the best value. Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (CSP) is the procurement method best suited for projects that are not schedule-sensitive nor subject to potential change. Some advantages of this method are the selection flexibility and the open aggressive bidding it provides. In reviewing the scope of the recommended project, administration has determined that CSP is the best value method for this project.
